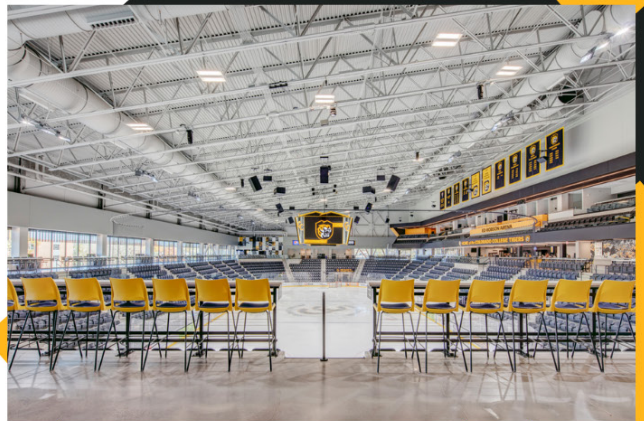

# ED ROBSON ARENA

**Colorado College's new Ed Robson Arena is a multi-purpose, state-of-the-art, sustainable sporting event venue that benefits both the college and the City of Colorado Springs. The arena is one of four unique Colorado Springs venues designed to strengthen and diversify the economic impact of Pikes Peak region visitor attractions.**

- \$65 million project
- Facility features:
  - Approximately 120,000 square feet for competition space, seating, locker and restrooms, concessions, storage, and administrative space
  - 3,400 permanent seats (350 student seats)
  - LED lighting and premiere sound system
  - A brand new, high-definition, center-hung video scoreboard
  - Glass windows throughout the arena with beautiful views of campus and the mountains
  - Chapman multipurpose room for classroom and meeting space (with serving space and outdoor plaza)
- Able to host ice and non-ice events
- Attached multilevel parking structure
- Unique food and beverage cart options
- Campus, recreation, club sports, and community programming opportunities

- Art installation areas in the student entrance and club level

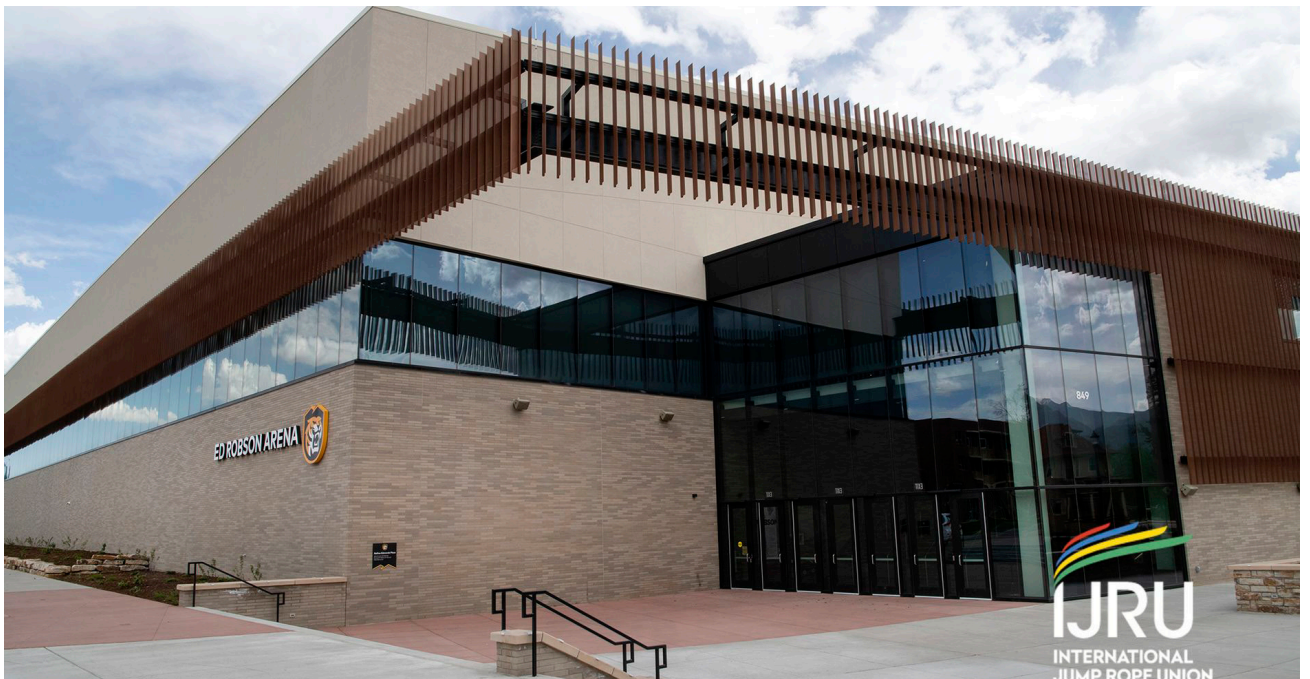

# IJRU WC Logo Information



The World Championship logo series was developed to represent both the overarching championship event as well as the individual competitions including the IJRU International Open Tournament, the IJRU Junior World Jump Rope Championships, & the IJRU World Jump Rope Championships.

The combination of the summer and winter elements, from the sunny views of the springs to the snow-capped mountains, is a large part of what makes Colorado Springs so special.

The logos were developed to include these elements.

- ▲ The Sun represents the Sun Mountain in Colorado & the head of a jumper
- ▲ The Rope is derivative of the Colorado “C” on the state flag
- ▲ “IJRU” forms the snow-peaked mountains representing the Front Range of the Rockies
- ▲ The blue of the mountains connects to the summer months and springs running around Colorado Springs
